

In keeping with this non-commercial spirit of national pride, you will be able to enter the pavilions of more than 70 nations free. The theme pavilions free. The private exhibits free. And on-site transportation. via the Expo Express, is free.


The greatest international spectacle to be presented in this hemisphere, Expo 67 a lifetime of world tours.

For the very first time in the history of the world an exposition will feature so many official foreign exhibits-the United States a lagoon-span away from the Soviet Union: Great Britain and France within strolling distance of Czechoslovakia; the emerging will show you more than you could see in nations of Africa and Latin America together with the ancient cultures of the Orient.


Man the producer: Man, his machines and resourcesshown in fascinating detailincluding today's problems and tomorrow's directions.


