ABSTRACT ART IN QUEBEC

For the first time at Man and His World, the young artists of Quebec will have their own pavilion. It is named "Forum des Arts" and is located in the former Philately pavilion.

These aspiring artists are showing their work under the title "Avec ou sans couleur" (With or Without Colour). The exposition comprises a wide range of abstracts, a form of art finding great favour among Quebec's young talents. They are painted in a plethora of styles from the simple (blacks, greys, whites) to the complex (vibrant or muted colours).

The show is faithful to Man and His World's theme for 1978: Customs, Folklore and Traditions. Indeed, abstract art has been with us in Quebec for more than half a century, and has evolved its own unique québécois style. The young artists at Man and His World are making yet another important contribution.
