Successor to "Expo 67"

"Man and His World", successor to Expo 67, will become a permanent, cultural and popular attraction of a universal and international character, similar to Expo 67.

Dates: From May 17 to October 14, 1968.

Hours: Exhibition Site: from 10 a.m. to 2.30 a.m.
La Ronde: from noon to 2.30 a.m.

Minimum: 80 pavilions

- 40 national pavilions animated by forty countries.
- 15 pavilions, government or private institutions.
- 22 other pavilions, containing exhibits conceived by the City of Montréal.
- Three theme pavilions (at least) will continue: Man the Provider (agriculture and food); Man the Explorer; Man in the Community.

Area: Same as in 1967, except for Cité du Havre.

- The same harmony and relationship as Expo 67: the same islands; the same view of Montréal; the same canals; the same lakes; the same vegetation; the same minirails; the same public areas; the same public services; the same sculptural decorations.
