

GENERAL INFORMATION

ADMISSION TO MAN AND HIS WORLD

Admission to the site of Man and His World is free. However, entry to the pavilions is by way of a visa. Cost of a one-day visa is \$3.50. A season visa costs \$5.00 allowing the visitor unlimited admissions throughout the season including access to the La Ronde amusement area.

Children

Children under eight years, if accompanied by an adult, are admitted free to all pavilions.

Groups - Youth

Cost of a one-day visa is \$1.00 for all visitors who are part of a group of not less than 35 children, or teenagers under 18 years.

Groups - Adults

For groups of 200 persons or more, adult visas cost \$2.00 each.

Admission to La Ronde

Visitors without a visa must pay \$0.50 enter the La Ronde Amusement area.

PARKING AT MAN AND HIS WORLD

There is space for 6,000 vehicles in parking lots adjacent to the site.

PARKING FEES - WEEKDAYS

\$2 per day for cars

\$2 per day for trailers

\$5 per day for camper-type vehicles over 20 feet long.

Chartered buses park free at all times at Man and His World

PARKING FEES - WEEKENDS

\$3 per day for cars

\$3 per day for trailers

\$5 per day for camper-type vehicles over 20 feet long.
