TRANSPORTATION

Included in the price of admission are the on-site transportation systems. The monorail runs the entire length of the site, stopping at stations in each colour zone. The two skyrides travel between the Folklife area and the Pavilion of Promise on the east side of the site and between General Motors and Air Canada on the west. Ferry service across False Creek links the plazas of the U.S.A., U.S.S.R. and People's Republic of China.

The EXPO 86 False Creek site is linked to Canada Place on Burrard Inlet by SkyTrain, Vancouver's new Advanced Light Rapid Transit. As you travel back and forth on dedicated trains, you remain "inside" the grounds of EXPO 86.

GATE SERVICES

All four Entry Gates to Expo, three at the False Creek site and Canada Gate at the Burrard Inlet site, feature a full compliment of facilities and services, including:

RE-ENTRY TO EXPO 86

Have your hand stamped at the exit turnstiles for re-entry through any Expo gate during normal operating hours on the same day.

HOURS OF OPERATION

All pavilions and facilities are open every day from 10:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. "Expo After Hours", the night-life area around B.C. Place and the Expo Theatre in the Blue Zone, features dining and entertainment until after midnight.

BANKS AND CURRENCY EXCHANGE

The Royal Bank of Canada has retail branches at all four Entry Gates. Royal Bank Personal Touch Banking machines linked to the Plus system throughout North America are available on both Expo sites. A full service American Express office is located in the Green Zone.

ENTERTAINMENT

There is a "World of Entertainment" taking place every day on both EXPO 86 sites on the streets and in theatres, pavilions, restaurants and cabarets. Further information is available at all Entry Gates and Information Booths. In addition, the Royal Bank/EXPO 86 World Festival offers internationally acclaimed performances from over 30 nations at Vancouver's civic theatres as well as on-site.

DISABLED

The EXPO 86 site has been designed and constructed according to the guidelines set for disabled access by the city of Vancouver. A guide to services and facilities for the disabled is available at the gates and information booths.

FIRST AID

Four first aid clinics staffed with qualified medical personnel are open during all operating hours. They are located near the Roundhouse, the Ontario Pavilion, at B.C. Place and at Canada Place. For assistance, contact any Expo employee or dial 6666 from any Expo phone.

Washrooms are conveniently located in most pavilions and restaurants and at many locations on both sites.

SERVICES FOR INFANTS AND CHILDREN

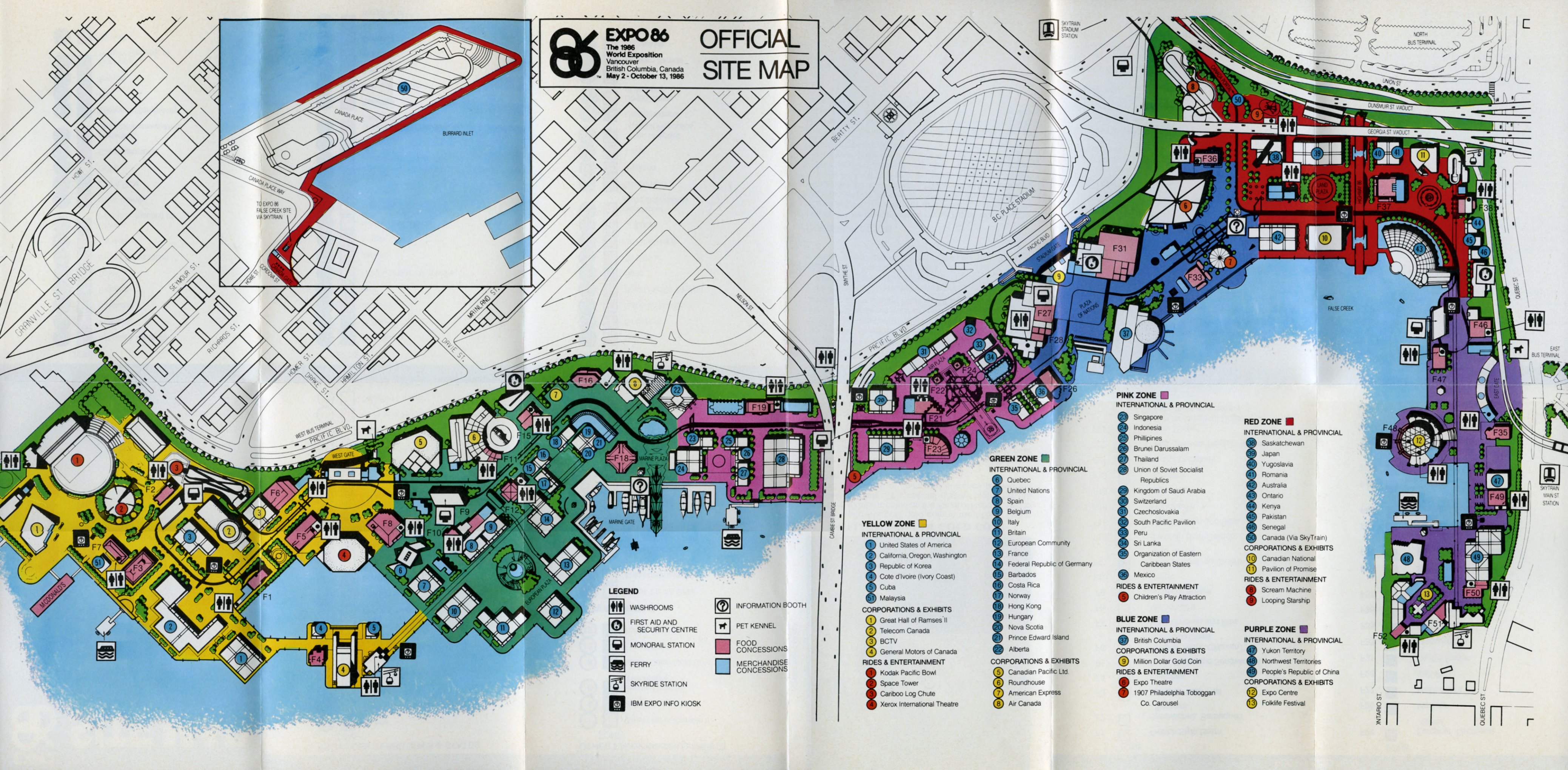
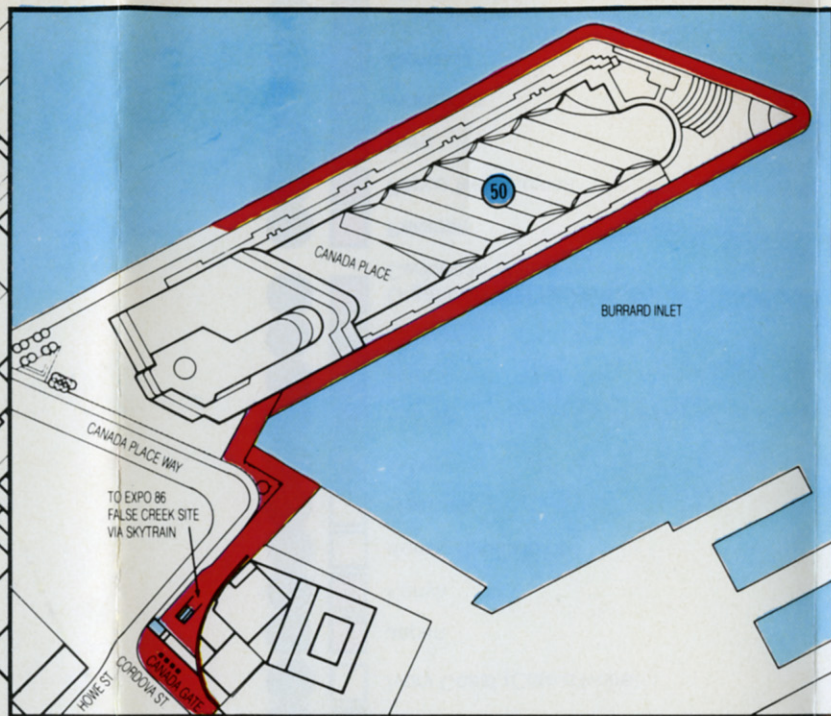
First Aid Facilities may be used as a place for diaper changing and infant care. Public Washrooms are also equipped for diaper changing.

MILLION DOLLAR GOLD COIN

See the world's largest gold coin in the Million Dollar Gold Coin Exhibit located on the Plaza of Nations next to the Stadium Gate. This special display highlights the historic importance of coins and currency around the world as a means of communication.

The giant coin measures over one metre in diameter, weighs more than 115kg and is certified to contain over one million dollars worth of gold at the time of minting. It is believed to be the largest gold coin ever made.

Experience the power of gold in this exciting, free added attraction. Look for it directly underneath the Stadium Gate Monorail Station in the Blue Zone.
