World's Fair House Opens in Glendora

A Southern California interpretation of the Formica World's Fair House, including many of the top features of the New York exposition model, will be opened today by Ivan B. Holmes, custom home builder, at his new estates community on Valley Center Ave., a half mile north of Foothill Blvd., in Glendora.

Hours for the first showing of the model are from 10 a.m. to 7 p.m.

This is the first home in Holmont Shadow Oaks, which will contain 20 homes in the \$45,000 to \$65,000 price range. The community, with ancient oak trees giving it a distinctively California setting, is in the rolling foothills of the San Gabriel Mountains.

New products and mater-

ials will be shown in this model along with new ideas for extending richness of living in the Southland, new designs, and new colors.

The model will show products of American Cyanamid Co. and its subsidiary, Formica Corp., including a new acrylicite "skydome" mounted in the roof to bring outdoor light into halls, closets or rooms which usually

are dark, and other new panels recently introduced by Formica.

Exterior features wide over-hangs, native stone and shake roofs.
