

WAX WORKS WILL LOCATE IN ANAHEIM

ANAHEIM- The owner of the Wax Works Museum at the New York World's Fair plans to move his production to the vacant Harris Restaurant at 1850 S. Harbor Blvd.

Louis Walter, president of Walter's Amusements, Inc., has announced the museum and a second show, "Paris Spectacular," will be shifted to a 2.5-acre site south of Disneyland.

The "Paris Spectacular" contains approximately 100 figures, some reproductions of paintings and statues in the Louvre.

The museum won approval from City Council March 9. A permit for partial demolition of the restaurant building has been granted by the Building Department.

However, no remodeling permit has been issued.
