

Texans at the Fair To Show the East How the West Eats

Texas has decided to show folks in the East just how big they feed people and entertain back home. And that includes juicy steaks, champagne and dancing girls.

It will all be done, the state's public relations people said yesterday, in nine restaurants that Texans will operate at the World's Fair, which opens in April.

According to the announcement, one will be able to consume "prime Texas steak" while watching dance hall girls perform in the kind of entertainment "that thrilled the old western pioneer."

The nine restaurants will be able to serve more than 50,000 people a day, it was reported. Five of them—the Beer Gardens, Modern Texas, Shrimp House, Gateway to Mexico and the Barbecue—will be in the Texas Pavilions.

The four others—the Drawing Room Lounge, the Champagne VIP Lounge, Champagne Circle and the Frontier Palace—will be housed in the Music Hall.

Listed among the food delicacies to be served are Texas fried chicken, Texas beefsteak and Texas hot dogs.

The announcement failed to say whether the dancing girls would be from Texas.
