

Helicopters Will Provide Highest Rides at the Fair

The highest rides at the World's Fair will be offered by New York Airways.

Sikorsky S-61 twin-turbine helicopters will begin rising from a heliport roof — 120 feet high — in the transportation section of the fair on April 22. Flights will be from 9:30 A.M. to 11 P.M.

The helicopter airline will use three of the 24-seat planes to take fare visitors on a 10-mile double-loop trip in a figure eight pattern. The view will encompass the New York skyline and Long Island Sound.

Fares will be \$6.50 for adults and \$3.50 for children 12 years of age and under.
