Maryland

Governor Tawes and group will visit Fair on November 9 to present plans for Maryland Pavilion.

New Mexico

General Potter will meet with Commission in Santa Fe on November 30. Displayer, Inc. is developing exhibit. The effect of defeat of Governor Mechem is not yet known.

Pennsylvania

Governor Lawrence has selected Commission members. Appointments will be announced shortly.

Puerto Rico

A telegram was received from Rafael Durand on November 1, 1962 cancelling participation. Attempts are being made to reopen the question based on admission charge to finance exhibit.

Tennessee

State officials have expressed renewed interest in exhibit. Fair's field representatives are in contact with state officials.

Toledo

City of Toledo considering exhibit based on position of City at head of St. Lawrence Seaway and the gateway to the West.

Utah

Governor of Utah is canvassing "four corner states" of Utah, Colorado, Arizona and New Mexico to see if he can pull together a joint exhibit. Utah representative visited Fair on October 26, 1962.
