

THE WORLD FESTIVAL OF

EXPO '74 is the abbreviated title of the International and Special Category Exhibition of 1974 . . . the first World's Fair hosted by the United States since obtaining membership in the B.I.E. (Bureau International des Expositions) . . . taking place in Spokane, Washington, U.S.A., from May 4 to November 3, 1974 . . . with the stated theme: "Celebrating tomorrow's fresh new environment."

One part of EXPO '74 is the World Festival of Entertainment . . . a unique program of the performing arts, spectaculars, sports and folkloric entertainment from six continents.

For six months the Exhibition will be open seven days a week, 10:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m., with the amusement area, The Great Northwest Midway, open until the last visitor leaves.

Daily World Festival events take place in several locations . . . the Opera House, the Coliseum, the International Amphitheatre and numerous Performing Corners of the Exposition grounds. Admission to the Opera House and Coliseum does not require an EXPO grounds admission ticket.




OPERA HOUSE SEATING

TERRACE LEVEL





BALCONY LEVEL


SEATING CHART
