




Extra efficiency, economy and flexibility are possible through the use of private or leased lines as an integrated part of your communications system.








In Centrex installations, modern, compact desk-top consoles replace bulky switchboards.

ATTRACTIVE, WALK-UP TYPE INSTALLATION

These may be wall-hung or flush-mounted in all appropriate locations throughout your exhibit. An integral part of the installation is a World's Fair map that highlights points of interest and pinpoints the location of the booth.

PUBLIC TELEPHONE BOOTHS WILL BE CONVENIENTLY LOCATED

Attractive blue-and-white open booths with especially favorable acoustical characteristics will be strategically located throughout the Fair in clusters of three to eight. These high-style installations feature an interesting scalloped effect and eye-catching illuminated roofs.

Wherever people gather, anywhere in America, they expect to find public telephones readily available. Certainly no exhibit catering to the public and competing for its favor and attention can be complete without making advance provision for adequate public telephone service.

We have developed up-to-the-minute equipment for World's Fair use. These telephones are designed to be mounted on convenient walls, recessed, or installed in booths of your own design to blend with any motif.

FAMILY BOOTHS WILL BE PART OF THE BELL SYSTEM EXHIBIT
