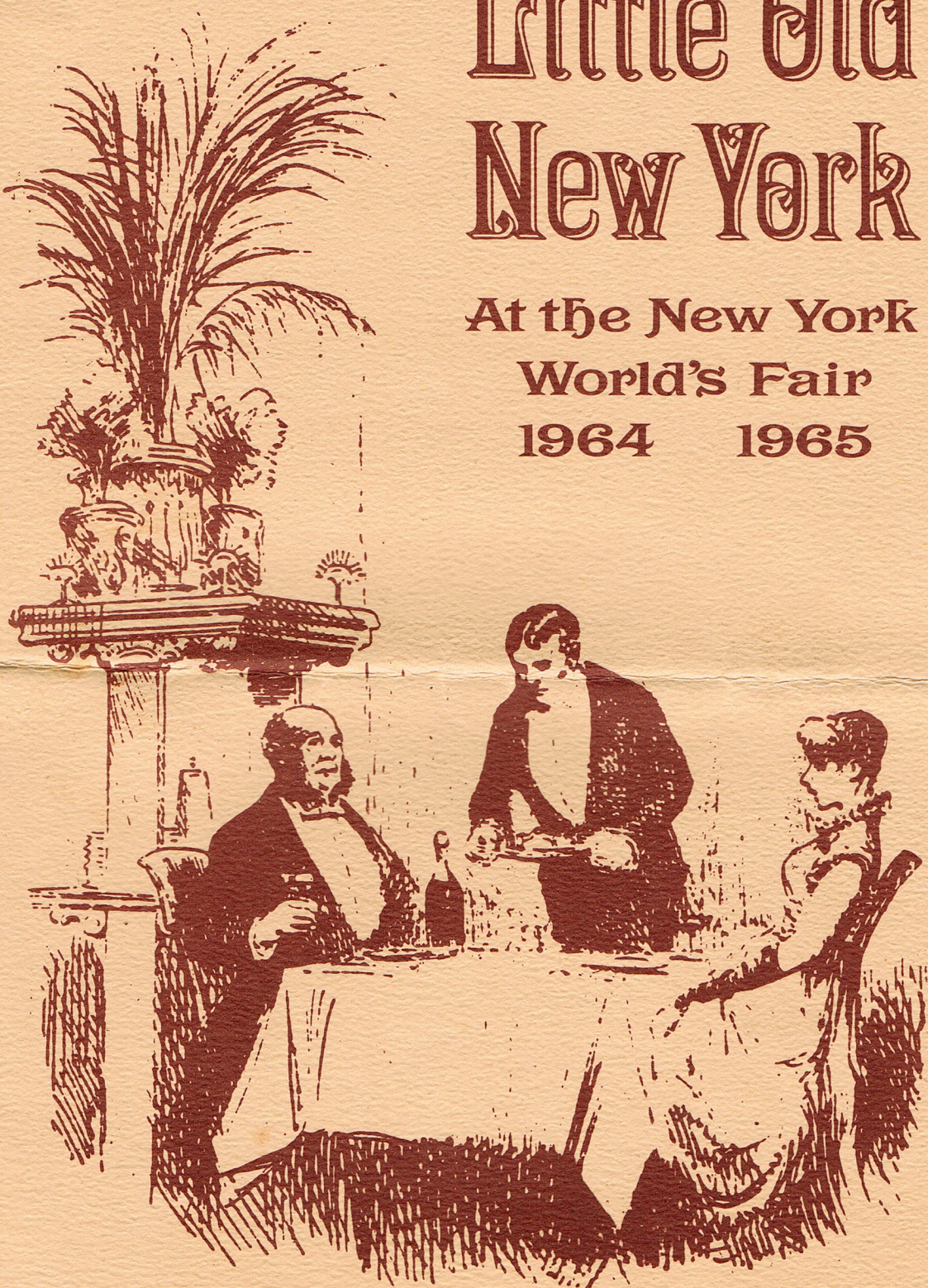

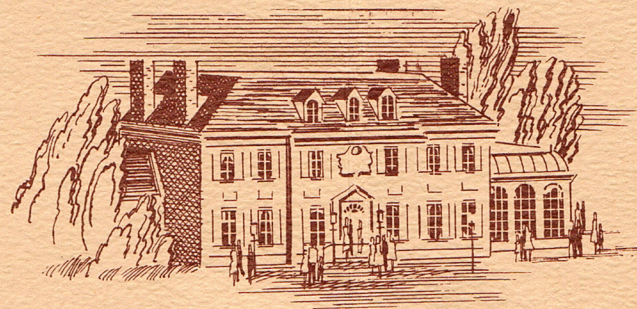

Tender tips of sirloin beef, combined with sliced mushrooms and simmered in wine and sour cream.

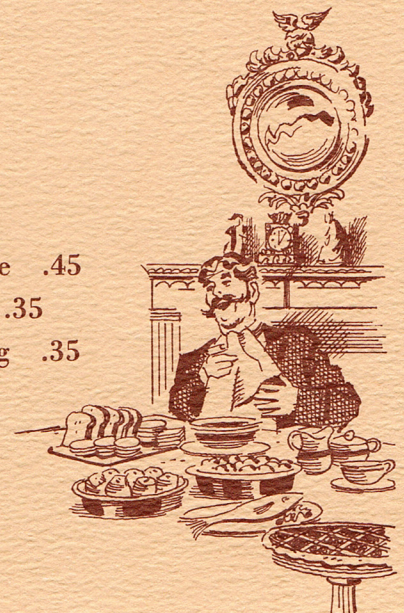
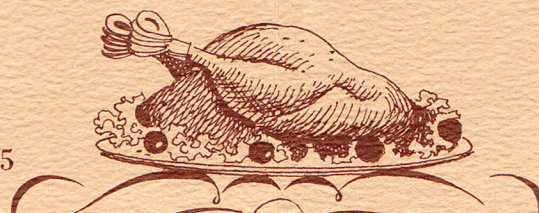
**Golden Fried Chicken 1.75**
